Dear Spring Mill Families,

Welcome to a brand new year at Spring Mill Elementary! We look forward to welcoming your family to our school this fall.

This initial mailing will include most of the key information you will need to get started. Please take the time to read through all of this information and orient yourself to the new school year.

Our Kindergarten Orientation, Ice-cream Social and Summer Packet Celebration will be from 5:00-6:30 p.m.

- Kindergarten families will get to visit classrooms, drop-off supplies, connect with the teachers, receive general information about the start of the year and have the opportunity to ask questions before joining the Ice-cream Social on the west playground (in the gym if it rains).
- At the Ice-cream Social, teachers of students in grades 1-5 will wait at their doors to meet students and collect school supplies. Please drop off supplies at this event to avoid having to bring them to school on August 1st.
- The Summer Packet Celebration for grades 1-5 will be held during the Ice-cream Social. All students should bring their Summer Packets to this event (regardless of which school gave them the packets in May), to receive an incentive for completing the packets.

Curricular information for grades K-5 will be shared at the Back-to-School Night on August 22<sup>nd</sup>. This is an event for parents only.

Please take advantage of the links on the MSDWT website to stay informed and prepare for the first day of school. Before school starts, please go to: <u>www.msdwt.k12.in.us/transportation</u> where you will find information to do a school/transportation search. When your child's busing information is posted online, you will receive a message letting you know that it is available in SKYWARD Family Access.

School reopens on August 1st. We request parents to send students to school on the bus to avoid crowds in our hallways while we welcome students on their first day back. We will have volunteers who will meet students at each bus and accompany them into the building. All kindergarteners will meet teachers in the kindergarten hallway and 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students will go directly to their classrooms. Students who do not know their class assignments will go to the cafeteria and staff will assist them. Parents are requested to follow the directions of staff and must not walk to classrooms.

Every Sunday we send a weekly message to families via phone and email. To receive these, please make sure your phone and email information is accurate in Skyward.

We know that with your active involvement and support, our students will make great strides this year. Enjoy the rest of your summer. See you soon!

	Kindergarten students meet their teachers in the Kindergarten hallway. Parents are welcome to stand on the side of the hallway only on this morning. Please do not enter classrooms.
	1 <sup>st</sup> -5 <sup>th</sup> grade students go directly to their classrooms.
	Students who don't know their class assignments should go to the café where staff and parent volunteers
	will assist them.
	Note: Spring Mill Road is busy during school arrival and dismissal times. Tardies will not be waived for
